CLEARING

The Clearing process is when universities and colleges advertise the places they have on courses that are not full, giving prospective students another opportunity to secure a place on a course this coming September. You could call it a plan B, often it can work out better than plan A. It is worth noting that not all institutions or courses appear in the clearing system so if you can not find them, contact the institution directly. You may also be able to request a clearing mini guide or attend a Clearing Advice Day.

You will be able to apply through Clearing if you:

- Have not done quite as well as you expected and you have not met the conditions of your offers
- Have not made a UCAS application this year
- Or if you have not received any offers (or none that you wanted to accept).

When is Clearing?

Clearing opens Wednesday 5 July for those who already have exam results or hold no offers.

Clearing officially opens on results day, Thursday 17 August.

Clearing closes on Wednesday 20 September

Adjustment?

Adjustment offers the chance to find an alternative course or place to study if you do better than you expected in your exams. Adjustment is available from Thursday 17 August until Thursday 31 August and is entirely optional. See UCAS website for more information
