# Higher & Degree Level Apprenticeships

**If the traditional college or university route isn't for you, apprenticeships offer a combination of on-the-job training with real salaries and real world potential.**

Apprenticeships are for anyone who is over 16, lives in England and is not in full-time education. For Higher and Degree Apprenticeships you'll usually need a level 3 qualification to qualify, which means you're likely to be at least 18 years old. You'll spend a minimum of 30 hours a week at work alongside industry professionals and be paid for your time!

Entry Requirements: 5 GCSEs (Grades A\*- C) and good results at Level 3 (A Levels, BTECs, Advanced Apprenticeship)

Higher Apprenticeships combine industry learning on-the-job with training in a college or university environment.

Degree Apprenticeships blend the best parts of both higher and vocational learning so you can achieve a full Bachelors or Masters degree at the end.
