It is with a great amount of pleasure that I am able to contact you to let you know about the workshop your child will be taking part in at school. The workshop is called Articulate! and your child will be working towards an English Speaking Board qualification.

Over the week, students will learn how to:

- Give a presentation using visual aids something they need to know how to do in school for project work, for college, university and for job interviews. They will be taught techniques that will help them to 'engage' with any group of listeners and that they will be able to use in all areas of life
- Speak from memory learning to memorise helps with all areas of learning and revising for exams
- Read a passage from a book in a way that engages and excites the listener this skill helps both with their literacy and encourages them to uses their voices to 'sell' themselves
- Learn how to listen and engage with their peers, examiner and teachers in a positive and confident manner they will practise listening to others which can be difficult. If we listen well, not only do we learn but we also find that people like us more!

On the Friday of the week that they are with us, they will take part in an assessment with an external assessor and gain the English Speaking Board Level 1 Award in Speech (Grade 2).

The whole week is dedicated to increasing your child's confidence and to give them the communication skills they need to help them during the rest of their school lives and beyond.

Students will not be sitting behind desks all week, in fact the week is extremely interactive and requires them to join in with games and activities as well as do research for their presentations, books and spoken pieces. It is a great week!
