What is Exeter Scholars?

Exeter Scholars is a free programme giving you the opportunity to develop your knowledge of what it is like to study at a leading university. It will provide you with:

What will I be doing?

All events and activities have been designed to help you make informed decisions about whether university is the right option for you and to help make the process of getting there as easy as possible.

Who can apply?

In order to take part in Exeter Scholars, you must meet the following general eligibility:

- ☐ Live in Devon, Cornwall, Somerset, Bristol, or Dorset
- ☐ Be studying at a non-fee-paying school (state school)*
- ☐ Be in year 12
- ☐ Have achieved a minimum of 8 GCSEs at grades 9–4 (A*–C), including GCSE Maths and English at grade 4 (C) and above
- Be a Home / EU registered student, or you expect to be so by the time you apply for higher education

And at least one of the programme eligibility:

- You live in a neighbourhood where a low percentage of young people progress to higher education, as defined by your home postcode
- You live in a low income neighbourhood, as defined by home postcode
- 3. You are in receipt of free school meals
- 4. You are eligible for school bursaries
- Your parents have not studied at university
- 6. You are or have been living in care*
- 7. You have caring responsibilities*
- 8. You have a disability
- 9. You are an estranged student*
- 10. You are a refugee or asylum seeker*
