The UCAS Applications activity is designed to inform students about the UCAS online platform and improve understanding of the UCAS application process.

Engagement

After taking part in this activity 90% of students agreed that they knew how to find out about course and study options for the future.



88% of students felt more confident about applying to study an HE course through UCAS.



91% of students said they had increased their understanding of UCAS, the HE applications process and personal statements, as a result of this session.

- The process of applying and accepting courses.
- You need to make a personal statement to put on the application.
- You recieve UCAS points from your qualifications that will determine what courses you are eligible for.



The evidence demonstrates that the UCAS Applications activity has made a considerable impact on the students' understanding of UCAS and the HE courses available, and on their confidence in being able to make an HE course application.
